Details of all competitions are given as follows:

A Rangoli Competition:

- ➤ Objective: To encourage students to celebrate festivals in an innovative way. Organizing such events help students to remain in close touch with their culture. Rangoli Competitions play an important role in motivating students to perform and outshine in their creative skills. It offers a chance for participants to gain substantial experience, adopt innovative techniques, showcase talents, analyze and evaluate outcomes and uncover personal ability.
- ➤ Total 24 students were participated in this competition. Theme of the rangoli design is e-Content. Miss. Nitanjali Mane coordinated this competition.

❖IT Quiz Competition:

In this competition mainly objective questions based on Computer Fundamentals and 'C' Programming were included. Quiz conducted in two rounds.


