Prof. (Dr.) Madhav Sarode welcomed all the members of the Cell to the meeting and asked Dr. Neelkanth Dahale, coordinator of the Cell to conduct the meeting proceedings. Dahale greeted all; he recollected to all the NAAC 4th Cycle process the till date. He conveyed that the process began in June 2022 itself when Prof. (Dr.). Madhav Sarode had taken a lead in this regard. The process began with IIQA approval on March 02, 2023 to the recent move of receipt of the Peer Team visit dates of 4th and 5th of the instant. Further, he conveyed all that the student representative on the IQAC was the girl student from the department of English Miss. Siya Surve. The proceedings went on taking the point number one.

- 1.1: To confirm minutes of the last meeting of the IQAC: The minutes of the previous meeting were confirmed unanimously.
- 1.2 To discuss about increasing ICT approach in TLP: Dr. Neelkanth Dahale read the point aloud to the meeting and shared it in pride that the IQAC would be happy to see all fellow faculty members be ready to make use of the ICT set ups completed in the classrooms. Many a member present nodded indicating that they use the LCD projectors made available in the classrooms and also extended the other online resources in the college website. Miss. Priti Nevse, member of the IQAC and head of the department of B. B. A. (C. A.) added that the video lectures and other e-contents developed by the faculty members were then uploaded in the college website. Miss. Siya said that the students browse on internet in the computer sets made them available I the department itself. The senior and specially alumni members present expressed happiness over the smooth flow of the academic processes being applied by the teachers and said that they were ready to extend assistance in financial form, if it was necessary. Principal said that the appeal would be made to the alumni members to extend such help when required. Dahale contributed that the move in the form of proposed MoU between IQAC and the Alumni Association was going to help in this regard. Mr. Vishal Masulkar, president of the Alumni Association shared that the point 6 in the same meeting would discuss it in more details. The point was approved unanimously.
- 1.3: To take review on POs and COs attainment: Dahale read the point and said that he had taken stock of the point during interactions with heads of the departments. He showed happiness over the achievement that all the departments across the various streams worked on the POs and COs attainment and shared that no department was below the point two in the three-point scale devised for POs and COs attainment. All approved the policy for further improvement.
- **1.4:** To discuss about student library services: Dahale read the point aloud to the meeting and requested Dr. Trupti Ambre, member on the IQAC and librarian to respond the point. She said that the timings of the central library extended and now it is from 8.00 in the morning to the 6.00 in the evening. Siya entered the discussion and said that she herself and the other students from Science and Commerce had provided the feedback to their respective departments for extending the library timings. Adv. Satish Gorde, member on the IQAC and an alumnus expressed happiness over the revised library timings and reminded that this revision would be helpful to the PG students in particular. The discussion was unanimously approved.



- 1.5: To discuss about Research Seed Money utilization: Dr. Sangeeta Ahiwale, Chairperson, Criterion III said that the Research Promotion Committee had conducted the project selection drive of the aspirant faculty members and ten faculty members were shortlisted to give financial assistance. She added further that the review had taken to see whether the projects were going on in right pace and quality. Dahale entered the discussion to remind all that Mr. Jalinder Katkade, member on the IQAC and an alumnus expected when donated the amount of Rs. 50,000/- that the amount be used for the research activities. All the alumni members congratulated him (Katkade) on his philanthropic act. All expressed pride over the point and approved the discussion.
- 1.6: To discuss about the MoU/ Linkage to be signed between IQAC and firms owned by Alumni: Dahale put the point before the meeting and reminded the discussion held in the previous meeting relating the signing of an MoU or linkage in the interest of the students. He specified that the students should get opportunities at industrial visits, listening to success stories of industrialists, provision of students' internships in industry and possible placements in industry. To add into it, Mr. Vishal Masulkar sir comforted all that the agreement document would open facilities and opportunities to the students in all possible respects as stated by Dahale. All the alumni members appreciated the initiative. Dahale informed the meeting that the IQAC would take initiative to execute this document. The point was approved by all unanimously.
- 1.7 Any other matter with prior permission of the Chair: Miss. Siya expressed her willingness over increasing the English language laboratory exercises for students of the department of English specially. Dahale replied that the existing laboratory exercises have recently been improved and of course, the sessions of the exercises would be increased.





Prof. (Dr.) Madhav Sarode welcomed all the member representatives of the Management, Industry, Society and Alumni of the college, the Steering Committee and chairpersons of the College-Industry Coordination Committee and Placement Cell to the meeting and conveyed the progress report of the NAAC 4th Cycle preparation of the college. He asked Dr. Neelkanth Dahale, coordinator of the Cell to conduct the meeting proceedings. Dahale greeted all. Next, the proceedings went on taking the points for discussion on the agenda.

- 1. To take review of the proceedings of the IQAC meetings held during the last five years: Dahale presented the IQAC report to the members present: he recollected the initiatives undertaken by the IQAC during the assessment period. He specially conveyed that the quality initiation began with conduction of the affiliating university sponsored three state seminars conducted by the departments in the 2017-18 proving the determination of the teaching fraternity of carrying quality profile of the college forward. His presentation particularly sensed the fact that the coordination between the IQAC and the entire teaching fraternity made the plannings to be converted into a success. The activities included application of the ICT in teaching-learning processes, e-mode in execution of different teaching, examination and official works, conduction of seminars/workshops and like. He highlighted the initiation and execution therein as per the NEP 2020 for the last two years specially. The discussion was confirmed unanimously.
- 2. To sign the MoU under the IOAC-Alumni Corridor: Dahale read the point aloud to the meeting and shared it in pride that the IQAC is happy to have such a committed alumni on the IQAC like the members present having industries of their own. He added that platform of the IQAC-Alumni Corridor should stand as the guiding authority here. Prof. (Dr.) Madhav Sarode asked Dr. Neelkanth Dahale, coordinator of the Cell to conduct the meeting proceedings. Dahale greeted all. Next, he introduced the importance of the awareness programmes needed on the NEP 2020 Policy. He added that the guidelines on the *Policy* have been descended to HEIs by higher authorities from time to time and its implementation is now at the threshold before us.

Principal guided the discussion: he said all the aspects in NEP 2020 are very much needed to be attended before the following year begins. He specified the aspects like credit (curriculum) framework in all the streams, importance of on-the-job training, community engagement and services and

crisscross offerings of courses under OE (Open Elective Course) and SEC (Skill Enhancement Course).

Dr. Pratima Kadam, Chairperson of the NEP Cell 2020 said that the awareness activities will help at getting the rationale behind all the aspects clear. Further, she suggested to organize such activities like workshops or so either on the own accord or with financial assistance from a higher agency, if any such agency, either UGC or university is providing funds. Principal assigned both the faculty members and IQAC coordinator to see whether any such financial help is available. He also asked to seek involvement from Lt. Prasad Bathe, Head of the Department of Mathematics in organizing such awareness workshops.

Further, Dahale reminded the two committee chairpersons to let the initiation of the activities be planned and implemented together with the IQAC and the two committees, seek guidance of the Steering Committee in preparing and finalizing them (proposed activities) and carry forward the implementation drive in coordination with the fellow members in their committees. 
